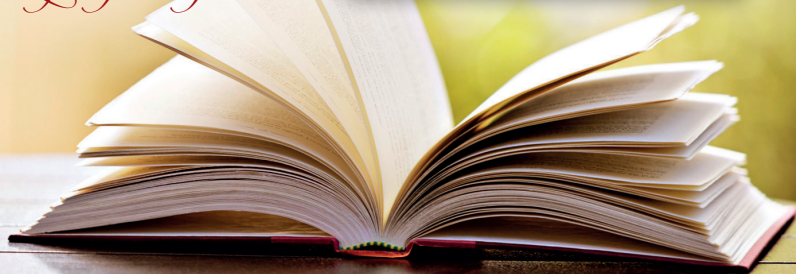
When Christ shall come with shout of acclamation

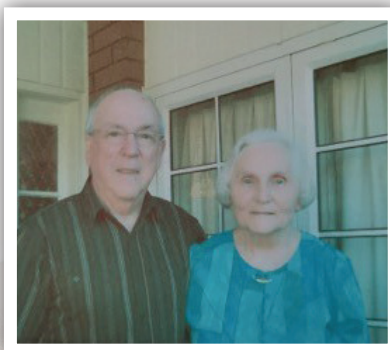

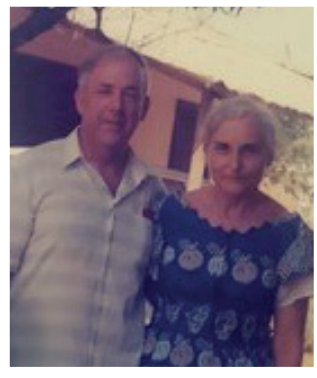

And hath shed His own blood for my soul

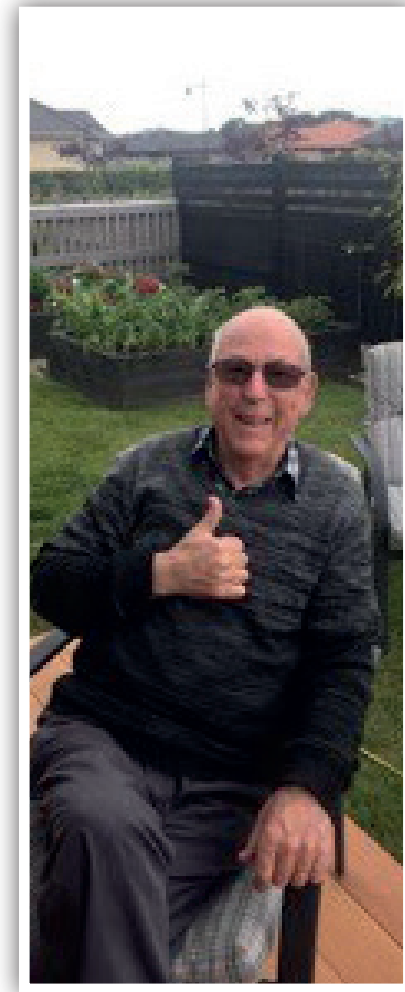
