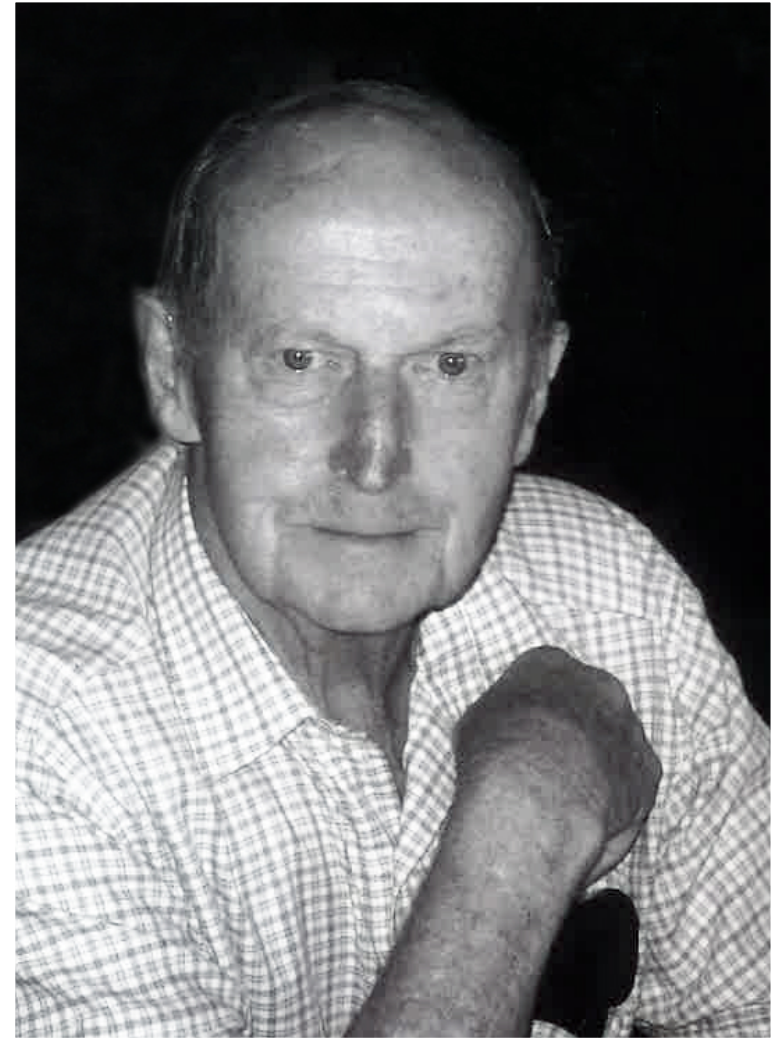


Grandad
