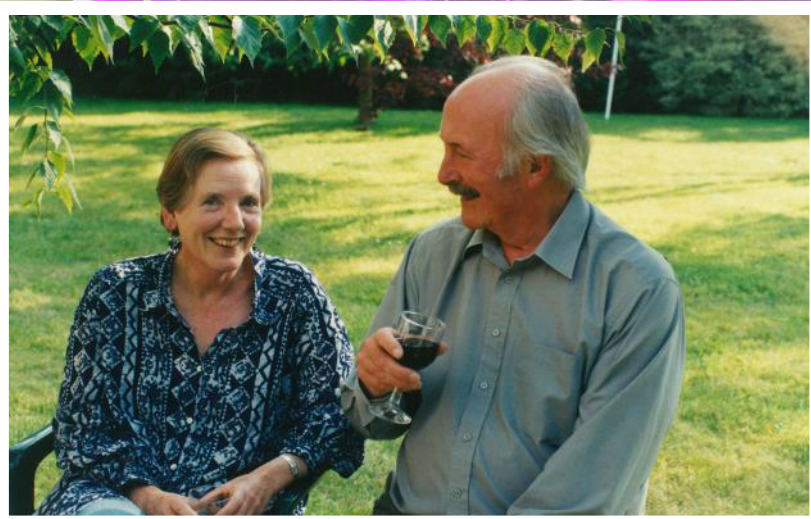

Tagore was the first Indian poet to win the Nobel prize for Literature in 1913. This is one of the "songs" in his collection, the Gardener, also known as his "Book of Love," that describes how love unifies humanity with the Universe.

Peace, my heart, let the time for the parting be sweet.

Let it not be a death but completeness.

Let love melt into memory and pain into songs.

Let the flight through the sky end in the folding of the wings over the nest.

Let the last touch of your hands be gentle like the flower of the night.

Stand still, O Beautiful End, for a moment, and say your last words in silence.

I bow to you and hold up my lamp to light you on your way.
